<b>Assignment Description:</b> This year marks the 20th anniversary since Japan's ODA was resumed and the 40th anniversary of diplomatic relations between Japan and Vietnam. On this occasion, looking back on the history of Japan's ODA for Vietnam, JICA conducts this study to review and evaluate the roles and achievements of Japan's ODA in the development of Vietnam and suggest future directions. The objectives of this study are as follows: (1) To clarify historical changes of Japanese ODA contents and underlying policies and perspectives of both countries in terms of sectoral and geographical focuses; (2) To analyze and evaluate the roles and achievements of Japanese ODA in the social and economic development of Vietnam; and (3) To provide suggestions for the future directions of Japanese ODA for Vietnam. This study is conducted by the study team organized jointly by the International Development Center of Japan Inc. (IDCJ), ALMEC Corporation, and NIPPON KOEI Co., Ltd.
