<b>Assignment Description</b>			
<p>The project analyzes and evaluates the Urban Master Plan 2000 currently being practiced in Great Abidjan; prepares a new urban master plan for the year 2030, including a sector plan for urban transport; and undertakes feasibility studies on high priority projects under the new plan. By so doing, the project aims to prepare a plan for sustainable urban development in line with national development policies. The project also contributes to strengthening the planning capability of the staff of Urban Development Department (UDD) under the Ministry of Construction, Sanitation and Urban Development (MOSHU). The project is carried out by a consortium of Oriental Consultants Co. Ltd., Japan Development Institute , International Development Center of Japan and Asia Air Survey, under the program of official development cooperation between the government of Cote d' Ivoire and Japan International Cooperation Agency.</p> <p>The project started in February 2012. It will end in November 2013. An effort is being made to prepare the inception report and discuss it with the staff of UDD, MOSHU, which is the counterpart to the project. A major progress has been made in field surveys, mapping, statistical data analysis and the discussion on possible options for long-term urban expansion.</p>
