<b>Assignment Description:</b>			
<p>Yangon City, currently with a population of 5.1 million people, is the largest economic center of Myanmar since recent dynamics toward democratization. This acts as a trigger for the inducement of foreign and private investments in Yangon City. However basic urban infrastructure has been deteriorated due to limited support of investment and technical assistant from foreign countries for a long time. Therefore, the capacity of infrastructure is not enough to serve the rapid development of economic activities and urbanization. Also, the absence of fundamental plan and data, such as mid and long-term urban development plan and basic urban data, could discourage a healthy development of Yangon City. Under such circumstances, the project aims to prepare a strategic urban development plan of the Greater Yangon, which covers not only Yangon city, but also adjoining townships under the influence of urbanization, to direct sound development with a time horizon of 2040.</p>
