Assignment Description:			
<p>Sichuan earthquake struck China's Sichuan province on May 12, 2008 leaving 87,000 deaths or missing and has affected up to 45 million people. Also it caused great damage to people's life line, such as public buildings and roads. While a rescue operation was undertaken by the government of China, the Red Cross Society of China (RCSC) appealed to the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Society (IFRC) for assistance in restructuring schools and health service facilities. To this end, The Japanese Red Cross Society (JRCS) had dispatched a resident JRCS representative officer for 5 years and provided JPY 5,175 million to carry out the distribution of relief goods, reconstruction of individual residences, schools, health service facilities, and disaster preparedness of RCSC.</p> <p>On April 14, 2010, another earthquake struck China's Qinghai province and caused 2,968 deaths or missing and affected up to 250,000 people. To this disaster, cash donations of about JPY 419,740,000 were made to JRCS. This was used to reconstruct schools and health service facilities, assist the populations in transitional shelters and support an emergency communication and commander vehicle. This was done to strengthen the disaster preparedness of RCSC. Subjects of this evaluation are bilateral cooperation between RCSC and JRCS for recovery programs on Sichuan Earthquake and Qinghai Earthquake.</p>
